

Club Showcase
Rules and Regulations
7th April 2018 16:45 – 20:15.

1. General.

- 1.1** All skaters are required to be fully paid up members of Guildford Ice Figure Skating Club (GIFSC) for the 2017/18 season.
If you are not a member by the closing date your entry will not be entered and you will not be allowed to participate
- 1.2** The personal details supplied by skaters on the application form will be held on computer files and used for the purposes of organising the competition.
- 1.3** This event will NOT be judged, it's a chance to 'showcase' your programs
- 1.4** Guildford Ice Figure Skating Club does not accept any responsibility for any loss of personal property or personal injury during this event.

2. Entry details.

- 2.1** The event classes are based on your current level.
- 2.2** The official entry forms must be used. **1 event per entry form. You can enter a maximum of 2 events** (this is to allow as many skaters as possible to enter) **Pairs and Groups please only use 1 entry form for all skaters involved.**
- 2.3** Please ensure that you state your current skating level in the events section (under the event you are entering) and the length of your program is entered, this is to assist in the making of a timetable. If you would like your music title announced, please enter this on your entry form.
- 2.4** Entries to the event will be treated strictly on a first received basis and will only be accepted on receipt of the full entry form.
- 2.5** **If any event is over subscribed, and if you have entered 2 events, priority will be given to Pairs / Groups section to allow a greater range of entrants to participate.**
- 2.6** Entry fee is **£5 per skater per event** payable on the day of the 'Showcase' when registering.
- 2.7** All entries must reach the competition secretary by 5PM on the closing date of **28th March 2018.**
No Late or verbal entries will be accepted.
- 2.8** **Email Entries ONLY**
The forms are available for download on the club website www.gifsc.com or on request from simon@gifsc.com and must be returned via email to simon@gifsc.com
Please do not hand your entry to a committee member as there is no way of tracing it if it goes missing, you are responsible for your entry.
- 2.9** In the case of uncertainty the Clubs Competition Secretary's decision is final

3. Event Information.

- 3.1** All skaters must be ready to skate at least 20 minutes before the time stated on the timetable.
Please be ready to skate when your name is announced, any late skaters may be unable to skate.
- 3.2** Any props used for the Artistic sections must be able to be carried on and off the ice by the skaters involved, no adults / coaches will be allowed onto the ice to assist.
- 3.3** The list of successful applicants and a provisional timetable will be emailed out and a copy placed on the club notice board soon as possible after the closing date.
- 3.4** All music must be submitted, at the time of registering on the day of the event, on a CD and clearly marked with the competitor's name, event entered and the length of the programme within a CD cover / case. There should be only one piece of music on the CD. The music must be in a format that is playable on a CD player and it is recommended that a backup copy of the music is available at ice level with your coach.
- 3.5** Please be aware that taking photographs with a flash camera is very dangerous to a skater and therefore will not be tolerated.
- 3.6** The categories will be as follows:
- Free Skate – All levels
 - Dance FD – All Levels
 - Adults Free / Dance FD – All Levels
 - Pairs Free / Dance FD – All Levels
 - Adult Pairs Free / Dance FD– All Levels
 - Artistic Singles
 - Artistic Pairs / Groups
